## Confirmation

Confirmation may be celebrated during the high school years for any student in 10th thru 12th grades who are registered with good attendance in LIFE TEEN on Sunday or Witnessing the Faith on Tuesday night and has completed Confirmation preparation.

## Sacramental Programs

First Reconciliation/First Eucharist

Sacrament preparation is separate and distinct from CCE classes.
